1. That has been written in the past year. Recommendation must be signed and written by an educator who can describe your:
 - Academic and extracurricular activities
 - Your desire for achievement

2. That has been written in the past year. Recommendation must be signed and written by a non-educator (employer, mentor etc.) who can describe your:
 - Personal attributes
 - Potential for future success

Step V: Transcripts

Please submit one official transcript (which includes your SAT or ACT and GPA scores).

Step VI: Turn in Application

Complete, sign, and return this application and required documentation to your counseling center at your high school. Applications will not be considered if it is submitted after February 25, 2011, is incomplete or has not been signed below.
